

## Swope Art Museum's 67<sup>th</sup> Annual Wabash Valley Juried Exhibition

### Calendar:

Postmark/ Email deadline: Saturday, April 9, 2011

Notifications sent via Email: May 10, 2011

Delivery of accepted work: May 17-28, 2011 (during museum hours or by appointment)

Exhibition on view: July 9 – August 27, 2011

Opening reception: July 9, 2011 4-6 pm, Awards Ceremony 4 pm

Art work pick-up: August 30 – September 10, 2011 (during museum hours or by appointment)

### Eligibility:

The Wabash Valley Juried Exhibition is open to all artists residing in Indiana, Illinois, Kentucky, Michigan, and Ohio. 2-D work must be no larger than 6 feet in any direction and cannot exceed 50 lbs.

3-D work must be no larger than 6x3x2 feet, and individual components of 3-D work cannot exceed 6 ft., 100 lbs consist of more than 25 pieces.

Submitted work must be original artwork completed within the last two years (2009-2011) and not previously exhibited at the Swope.

**Juror:** This year's distinguished juror is Janie Welker curator at the University of Kentucky Art Museum, Lexington. Formerly of the Heckscher Museum of Art in Huntington, NY and the International Center of Photography in NY, she has also worked at the Brooklyn Children's Museum and as an editor and reporter on the visual arts for various periodicals including Newsday. Welker received a bachelor of arts in journalism from Penn State and a masters in Art History from the State University of New York at Stony Brook.

### Awards:

Over \$5,000 in purchase awards and merit prizes are awarded annually. Purchase awards become the property of the sponsor/buyer at the close of the exhibition. Works marked NFS are not eligible for purchase awards, however they are eligible for merit prizes.

### Entry Fee:

There is a \$30 (\$25 for Swope members) non-refundable entry fee, payable by cash, check, credit card or money order.

### Entry Procedures:

Each artist may submit images of up to three works of art (two views per sculptural work).

Submissions may be made digitally via email or a CD sent through the post. See submission specifications below.

Accepted work must arrive ready to exhibit and in re-useable packing materials. (No Packing Peanuts!)

Label accepted work with: name, title, date, medium, value, if the work is for sale and mark the top.

All wall hung work must arrive with adjustable hanging hardware, no saw-tooth hooks.

Frames with glazing should use acrylic glazing or plexi, **absolutely no glass**.

Stretched canvases do not need frames, but should be presentable (no frayed edges), and require hanging hardware.

All work delivered in pieces must include written assembly instructions.

Any accepted/delivered works that differ in quality or are not representative of the digital image file may be disqualified at the discretion of the juror.

### Insurance & Sales:

The Swope Art Museum will insure all exhibited works for the duration of the exhibition at their estimated sale price. Sales are encouraged, but not required. The Museum will take a 30% commission on sales (or 10% commission from purchase awards). If no insurance/sale value is provided, the Swope staff will estimate a value for the object for insurance purposes.

### Pick-up / Return of exhibited work:

Accepted work cannot be withdrawn before the close of the exhibition.

Work must be picked up between August 30 – September 10, 2011 during museum hours, or by appointment.

If shipped, the Museum will repack the work but the artist is responsible for payment of return shipping, and the work must arrive in re-useable packing materials. Work not picked up 30 days after the close of the exhibit will become the property of the Swope Art Museum and will be disposed of at the staff's convenience.

Danette exhibited widely, won numerous awards at the Swope's Annual Wabash Valley Exhibition, and is represented in the Swope collection.
